There are just over 8,729 businesses in Cockburn, operating across various industrial sectors. Noteworthy is the standout performance in clustering of key strategic industries such as marine shipbuilding, defence support, construction, manufacturing, transport-related businesses and support industries for sea-based petroleum, oil and gas.

The City of Cockburn's Gross Regional Product is estimated at \$10.9 billion, representing 3.3% of the state's GSP (Gross State Product). Cockburn Industries provides about 27.4 per cent of the southwest region of Perth employment.

Strategic business areas exist in Henderson (the internationally regarded Australian Marine Complex), Bibra Lake and Jandakot Industrial Precincts, the Jandakot Airport Specialised Centre, Cockburn Central, as well as the mix of high-quality regional level retail and commercial centres.
