WALGA Training proudly offers a special eLearning subscription to support the Local Government sector with eLearning training opportunities for workers who are required to quarantine due to COVID-19.

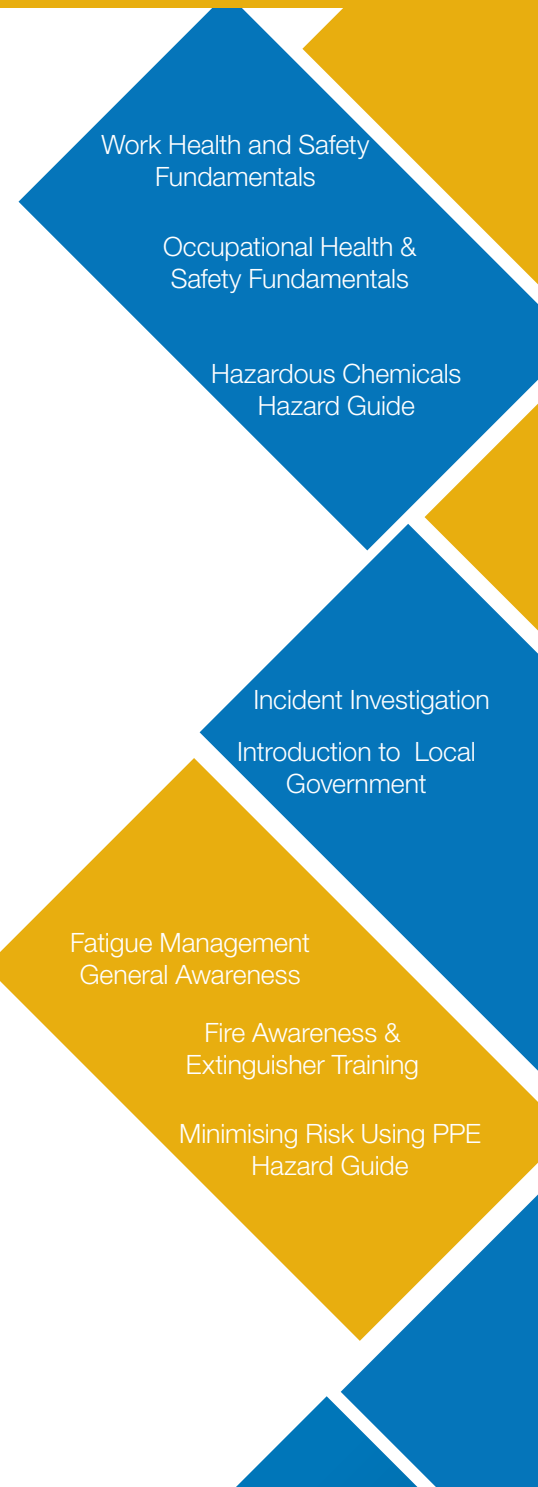
Training can be accessed via an electronic device and participants are able to complete up to 15 short courses within a 12-months subscription period.

Course Name	Duration	Course Summary
Introduction to Local Government	35 mins	Provides knowledge about the way Local Governments are constituted, the separation of roles between the Council and the Administration and the responsibilities of working in a compliance environment.
Hazardous Substances and Dangerous Goods (Vic & WA)	15 mins	Provides an understanding of the controls that should be applied to hazardous substances and dangerous goods in the workplace.
Fatigue Management Awareness Training	90 mins	Provides an understanding of the basics of sleep; concepts of the body, clock, sleep cycles and sleep debt; the main causes of fatigue; warning signs and high risk times for fatigue; health effects of fatigue etc.
Fire Awareness and Extinguisher Training	60 mins	Provides an understanding of fire safety and how to use portable fire equipment to extinguish a fire.
Hand Operated Power Tools	10 mins	Provides an understanding of the controls that should be applied to using hand operated power tools in the workplace.
Hazardous Chemicals Hazard Guide	10 mins	Provides the learner with an understanding of the controls that should be applied to hazardous chemicals in the workplace.
Incident Investigation	65 mins	Provides an overview of the legislative requirements for incident reporting and investigation and the knowledge and practical advice to conduct an investigation successfully.
Manual Handling Hazard Guide	10 mins	Provides the learner with an understanding of the controls that should be applied to manual handling in the workplace.
Manual Tasks for Workers	55 mins	Provides workers with an understanding of the risks associated with manual tasks and an awareness of how to perform those tasks safely.
Minimising Risk Using Personal Protective Equipment Hazard Guide	10 mins	Provides an understanding of why personal protective equipment (PPE) is used in the workplace, their PPE responsibilities and some commonly used items of PPE.

Working at Heights Hazard Guide	10 mins	Provides information about working at heights and some of the common situations where working at heights may be required, and controls that should be applied to reduce the risk associated with working at heights.
