





Clear and understandable targets across all aspects of sustainability

A holistic snapshot

clear goals/targets, indicators easy to measure

Progress view

Strategic community plan objectives since this is a common framework... Sustainable Development Goals but in an opt-in format

The ability to demonstrate the financial, social and environmental benefits / business case for investment into sustainability. Tracking of progress over time. Simplicity.

Reporting that integrated with other reporting tools eg. CDP, Waterwise councils

SDGs, Waste, Water, Energy, Emissions, sustainable development, benchmarks

objectives, indicators and targets, supported by good consistent data SDG's, indicators, benchmarking

Should link to corporate & business plan, key targets, indicators, guidance and - Global reporting Intiative which has KPI's set for reporting

Retention of Native Bushland Increased wetland & waterway buffers (30m is simply not enough!) indicators and systems to monitor/collect data

Easy and accessible for end user


Complexity can lead to high costs of operation and may be preclusive for some smaller LG
