Identifies and protects heritage places


Supports heritage property owners

Local Heritage Survey Review - Precinct by Precinct










Elevate it

- "... Several events in the local area contributed to the demand for milk from Hancock's dairy. During the First World War, one of the largest customers in the area was the Australian Imperial Forces army camp at nearby Blackboy Hill. Over the period 1914-1918, 32,000 men received their initial training there and even when the war ended, over 1,500 patients were treated in the camp hospital for the subsequent influenza epidemic of 1919..."



Park Street Heritage Area Timeline




A significant heritage outcome
