Please note we cannot give advice over the phone as our responses go through a review process to ensure accuracy and relevance.

## Monthly Newsletter

We issue a minimum of ten electronic newsletters a year, containing information relating to legislative changes and current topical issues impacting local government. These newsletters also include recent and relevant enquiries received (without identifying the origin of the enquiry) to highlight issues and information that may be of general interest across the industry.

When legislative changes affecting local government are announced, or there are any matters of interest attracting attention in the media, special alerts are released highlighting the likely impact.

To ensure the newsletters are received by the officers dealing with matters such as the administration of FBT, GST, and other indirect tax, it is essential they are on our distribution list. ## Advocacy
