Jacqui Dodd Scholarship



LGA50220 Diploma of Local Government – Elected Member

The Diploma of Local Government – Elected Member is nationally recognised within the Australian Qualification Framework (AQF) and consists of 10 Units of Competency. It is delivered through 9 structured workshops, commencing with a Foundation Workshop linked to Council Member Essential Training.

- **Commencement:** Wednesday, 11 November 2026
- **Duration:** 12-24 months (dependent on workshop scheduling). Scholarship recipients must complete the qualification within 18 months.
- **Attendance:** Nine mandatory WALGA workshops delivered in West Leederville, or via Zoom (total of 10 days). Each workshop is followed by a one-hour online mentoring session via Zoom to support assessment preparation.
- **Time Commitment:** In addition to workshop attendance, participants should allow approximately 20–30 hours per unit for research, reading, and assessment preparation.
- **Available Scholarships:**
 - 2 x Metro Scholarships
 - 2 x Regional Scholarships

Eligibility Requirement

To qualify for the Jacqui Dodd Diploma Scholarship, applicants must:

- Be an Elected Member currently serving on a Western Australian Local Government Council.
- Have successfully completed all Council Member Essentials Training.
- Have not previously been awarded the Jacqui Dodd Diploma Scholarship.

Application Requirements

To apply for the Jacqui Dodd Diploma Scholarship, applicants must submit:

- A written statement of 250–500 words outlining the benefits of this professional development opportunity to themselves, their Council, and their community. The statement must also demonstrate how the applicant will meet the required study commitments and explain how they plan to balance their studies with existing responsibilities, including full attendance at all WALGA workshops and mentoring sessions, as well as time for assessment preparation.
- A current digital profile picture.

Scholarship Benefits

- The scholarship will cover 50% of the training and assessment fees up to the value of \$5,085.
- Regional applicants can apply upon successful completion of the program for reimbursement for travel expenses of up to \$1,000 (receipts must be provided).
