# COURSE OVERVIEW



WALGA's RoadWise delivers the nationally recognised training 52862WA Course in Type 1 Child Car Restraint (CCR) Fitting.

### COURSE INFORMATION

This course is aimed at individuals who:

- Are looking to provide information and advice and/or a CCR installation and inspection service to the community or their organisation.
- Currently have or intend to obtain \$10 million Public Liability insurance (required to become an authorised Type 1 CCR Fitter).
- Agree to and abide by the *Business Rules for Fitters*.

WALGA's RoadWise delivers the course as two separate Units of Competency (UoC), the first UoC, CRFPPIA301, is a pre-requisite for the second UoC, CRFPRL302.

On successful completion of the 52862WA Course in Type 1 CCR Fitting, and registered as an authorised Type 1 CCR Fitter, individuals are required to:

- have obtained a Statement of Attainment for 52862WA Course in Type 1 Child Car Restraint Fitting,
- signed and agreed to abide by the *Business Rules for Fitters*, and
- maintained \$10 million Public Liability insurance.

### COURSE UNITS

#### Unit One - CRFPPIA301

##### Provide information and advice on correct child car restraints

This theory-based unit aims to increase the participants knowledge and the ability to provide advice and information to others. It can be completed as a stand-alone, single unit.

**Delivery method:** Self-paced/online modules.

**Time commitment:** 7.5 hours of training, plus assessments.

- Aimed at individuals who use CCRs and/or provide advice as part of their role.
- Participants must have a basic level of numeracy, language and computer literacy skills,
- WIFI access to ensure successful participation.
- Participants are required to successfully complete all components of Unit One in no more than three months.
- On successful completion of this UoC, participants will be eligible to enrol into CRFPRL302.

#### Unit Two - CRFPRL302

##### Install child car restraints

This unit extends the knowledge gained in CRFPPIA301 and trains practical installation and inspection skills.

**Delivery method:** Online facilitated sessions.

**Time commitment:** Eight hours of training, plus 1:1 practical assessment (1.5 hours) and independent assessments;

- Participants will need a level of physical agility, visual acuity, and mechanical aptitude to complete installations and inspections.
- Individuals are required to sign and agree to abide the *Business Rules for Fitters* and maintain \$10 million Public Liability insurance to become an authorised Type 1 CCR Fitter.
- Participants must have access to a vehicle, two different types of CCRs and headphones, a mobile device or computer with WIFI access to complete the assessments.
- Participants are required to complete all components of Unit Two in no more than three months.
