## ***South Fremantle Solar Farm***

### ***Project Background***

In 2014 the City of Fremantle issued an Expression of Interest offering a long term lease for the City-owned portion of the South Fremantle landfill site for the development and operation of a solar farm. In August 2015, the City of Fremantle entered into an Exclusive Working Agreement with Epuron Projects Pty Ltd.

Epuron Projects Pty Ltd is a Sydney based Australian company that has developed numerous renewable energy projects in Australia. Epuron has developed and operates several large scale solar and wind projects including operation of solar farms in 5 locations in the Northern Territory.

Environmental Responsibility is a strategic area of focus under the City of Fremantle's Strategic Community Plan 2015-25. The City aims to develop environmentally sustainable solutions for the benefit of current and future generations. The development of a Solar Farm on the former South Fremantle landfill site supports this objective.

### ***Project Status***

The project will cover approximately 6.5ha and generate up to 6MW of power. A Development Application for construction of the solar farm was approved by the City in April 2018 subject to preparation and approval of site and construction management plans and environmental approvals being achieved under the Contaminated Sites Act.

The business plan for the proposed 25 years lease was approved by Council in September 2018. A further term of up to 15 years could be negotiated.

Epuron is working on environmental approvals and while the lease cannot be executed until all environmental approvals are in place, Epuron is now close to securing Western Power approval and is working on power purchasing agreements with potential customers including the major power retailers. Subject to approvals, construction is likely to begin in autumn 2019.


