

Pavement Marking and Signs – NEW Installations

Introduction

Who is Traffic Services (TS)?

Traffic Services, part of the Road Network Services Directorate, provides leadership and specialist advice on traffic engineering, procedures and practices for State roads and for signals, signs and road markings on all public roads.

What is ISA?

The Metropolitan Integrated Services Arrangement is a long-term relationship-based arrangement with DownerMouchel to deliver operational asset management services. These services include the delivery of pavement marking on all public roads within the Metropolitan Region.

STEP 1

The LG or developer submit a request for installation of new pavement marking and signs to Traffic Services. Developer submissions must be accompanied by a letter from LG stating concurrence with the geometric design. Submissions must conform to Main Roads current standards and practice.

STEP 2

The submission will be allocated to the responsible Traffic Services area coordinator and officer for review and approval as appropriate. Approved plans and supporting information are returned to the LG/ Developer. A copy of the approved plans are forwarded to ISA. Non-conforming submissions will be returned for amendment.

STEP 3

ISA issues site availability forms and Provision of Services (POS) estimate (if applicable) to LG / Developer. Delivery of Services (installation of pavement marking and or signs) associated with grant funded (e.g. Black Spot program) and developer funded projects (e.g. subdivisions) is provided by a Provision of Services (POS) agreement. An estimate to complete the work will be issued along with site availability forms. Payment must be received to ensure delivery of works is completed. Non payment will result in delays to the provision of services.

STEP 4

LG/Developer arranges payment (if applicable), spotting and sweeping and notifies ISA by e-mail to metroisamcw@mainroads.wa.gov.au of the site availability.

STEP 5

The ISA issues the pavement marking and or signs approved plans to the subcontractor for delivery.

STEP 6

The appropriate ISA subcontractor install pavement marking and signs in accordance with the approved plans and notify ISA upon completion.
