- Significant contributions to the community through Local Government;
- Outstanding achievements and / or significant contributions in the advancement of the position and value of WALGA and / or Local Government within the wider community.

PRIVILEGES

- Local Government medal, certificate and lapel pin.
- Complimentary registration at all Association Conferences (not including travel, accommodation, meals or functions).
- Automatic nomination for Australian Honours / Western Australia Week Awards.

IMPORTANT NOTES

Nominations must be submitted via email to honours@walga.asn.au before the closing date of **Friday, 24 June 2022**.

- Please refer to the nominating authority section on the next page to ensure that an eligible nominator has been identified to support the nomination.
- Nominations from Member Local Governments require the support of the Nominator (who must be an Elected Member) plus two other Elected Members and the Chief Executive Officer.
- Nominations submitted by State Councillors do not require supporting signatures.
- When submitting your nomination, please also provide a high-resolution photo (no less than 1mb in file size) of the Nominee. The photo should be passport type (head and shoulders) and in colour.
- Nominations will not be accepted for persons who have retired or ceased working for Local Government before 31 December 2019.
