- Nominations from Member Local Governments require the support of the Nominator (who must be an Elected Member) plus two other Elected Members and the Chief Executive Officer.
- Nominations submitted by State Councillors do not require supporting signatures.
- When submitting your nomination, please also provide a high-resolution photo (no less than 1mb in file size) of the Nominee. The photo should be passport type (head and shoulders) and in colour.
- Nominations will not be accepted for persons who have retired or ceased working for Local Government before 31 December 2019.

Please note: due to the strict age requirement for this award, the Panel's decision to present an award to a Nominee is conditional upon verification of the Nominee's date of birth by the Secretariat.
