July - August 2019 **Governance and research:** P609, South Perth local history, South Perth Historical Society, ARG and Elders, conduct with Landgate **Council endorsement:** Mindeerup as preferred name and to commence process for naming geographic place

September 2019

SWLSC: Application to Whadjuk Working Party for consideration of name

October 2019

Formal application to Landgate: Guidelines, meetings and application

SWLSC: Not on agenda for Oct 2019 meeting

November -December Consent and acknowledgement: Meetings with local Elders and ARG

Formal approval: Landgate approval as a primary geographic place - 14 November 2019

Mindeerup: 'place of the shore' **Naming:** 16 December 2019





For Noongar, talking about one place as if it exists in isolation is akin to talking about people as if they exist in isolation from their community.



The same place may have many names according to who is using it, for what purpose and at what time of the year. Women and men may have different uses for the same place, or several events may have occurred in a place, resulting in it having several names. Also, if the name is descriptive, for example, dark or black water, the same name might occur in several places – wherever dark water is found.
