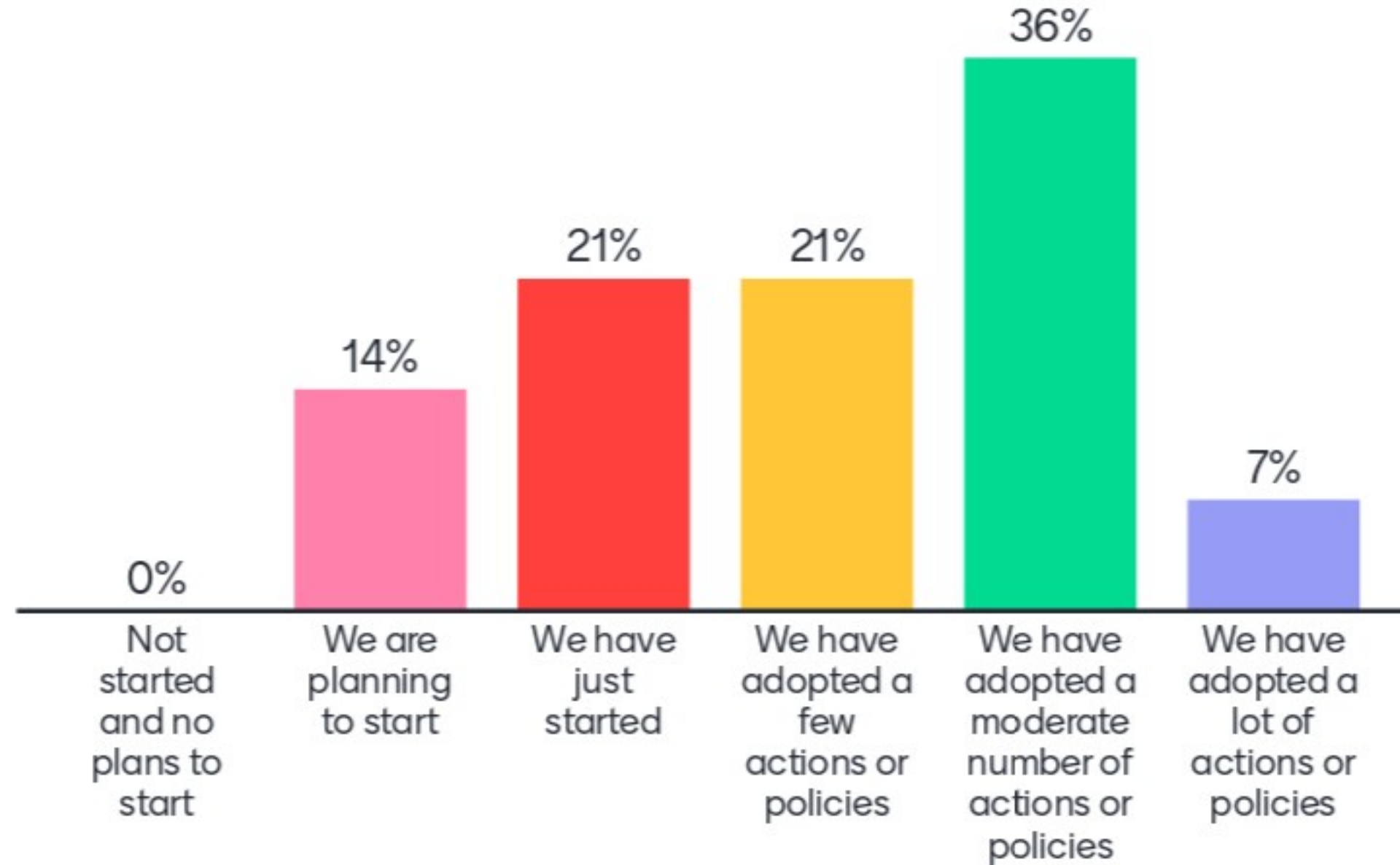

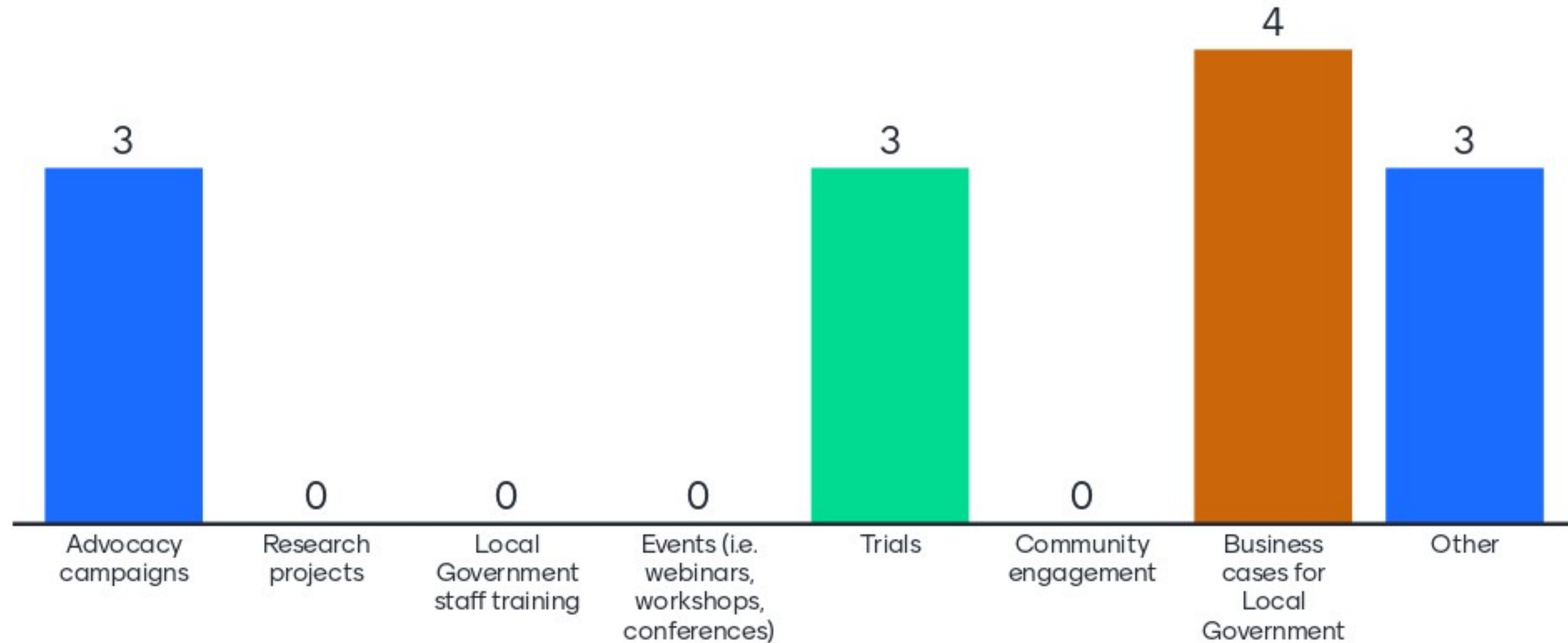




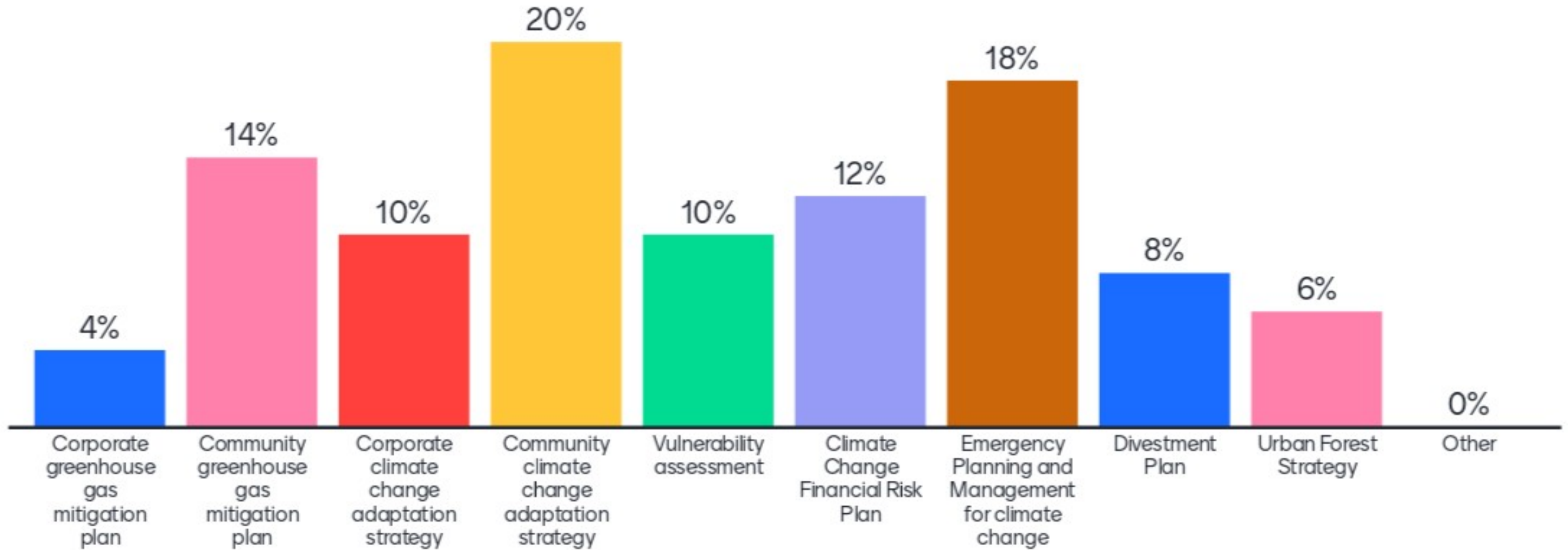
# What governance arrangements do you think would work best?

# What special projects do you think these climate alliances should work on?

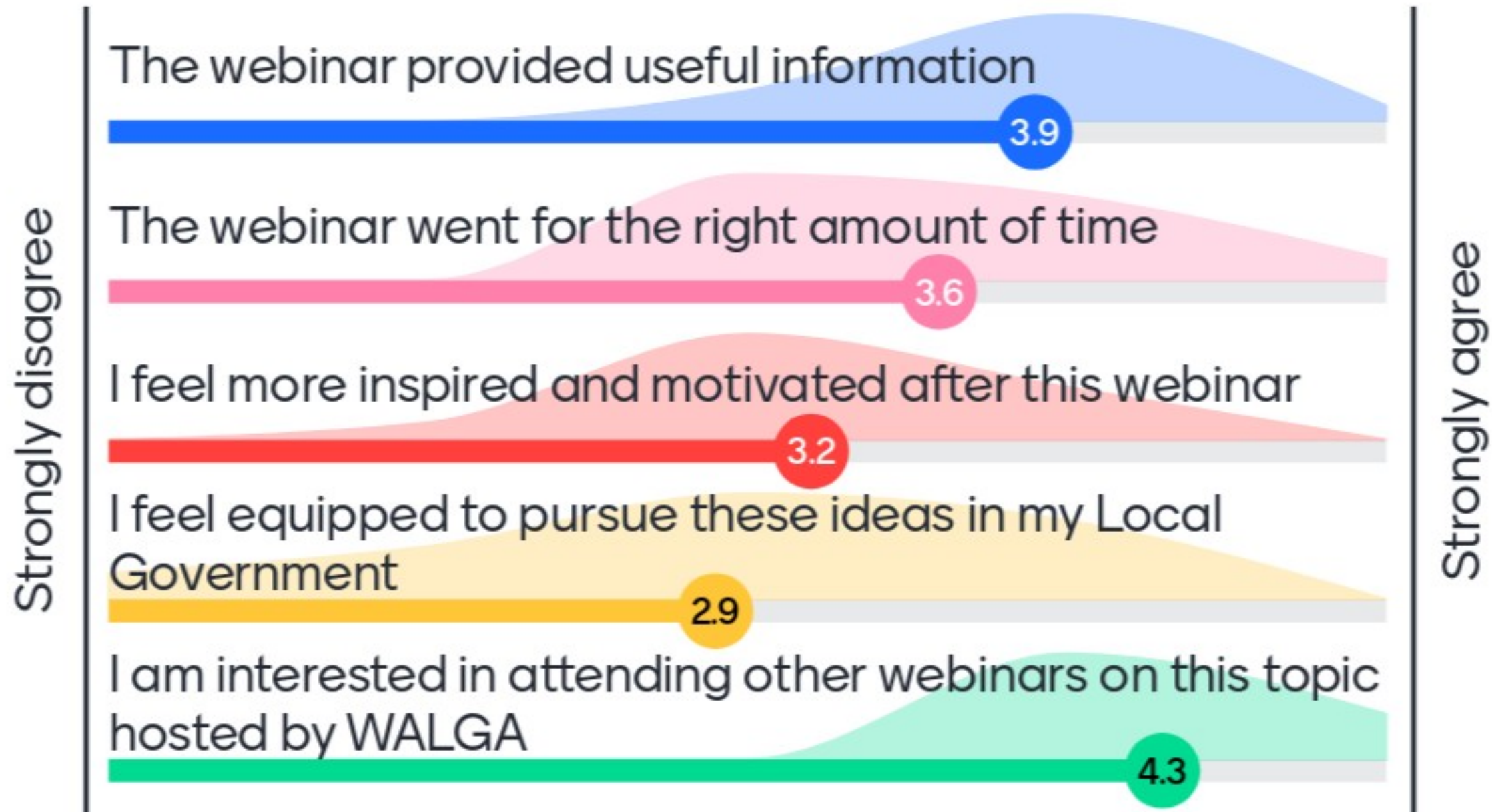
