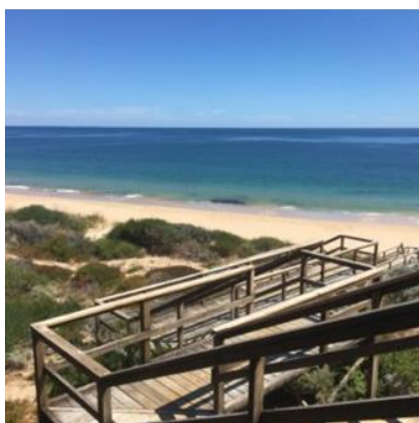

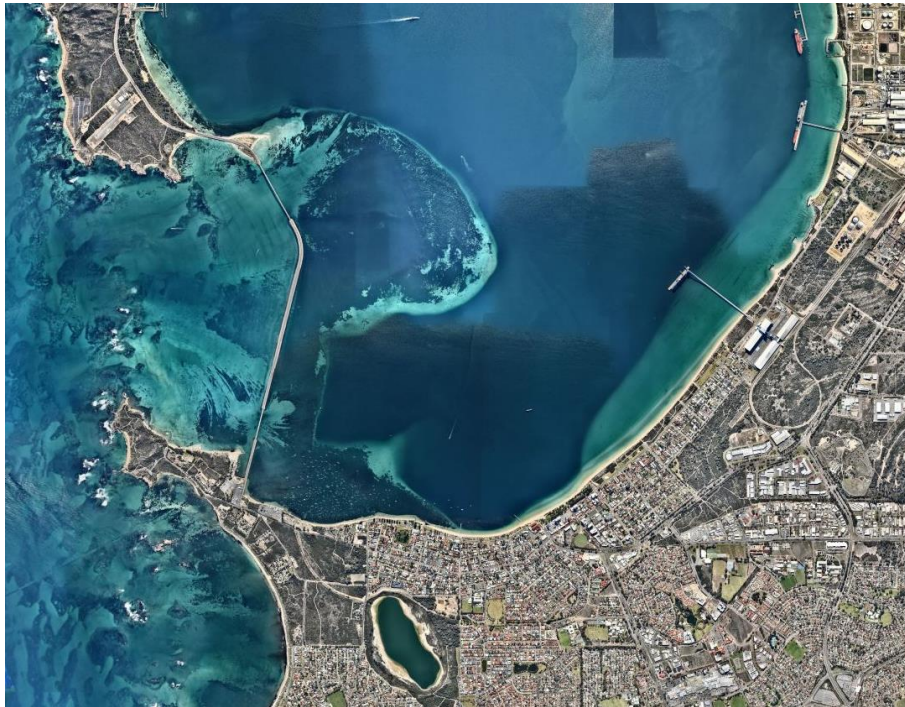

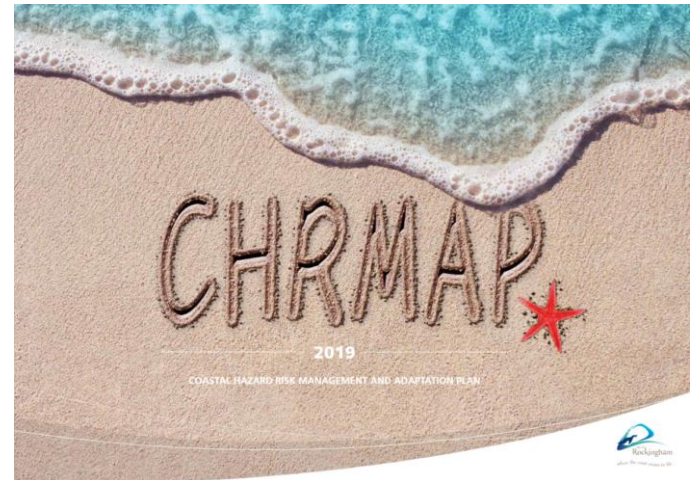
Key Projects

Benefits to the City

Comparing Approaches

- Peron Naturaliste Partnership

- Larger group
- Greater variation in views – more difficult to reach agreement
- Elected member involvement
- More complex governance arrangements – strategic plan
- More influential
- Reduced risk to member organisations through incorporation

- Cockburn Sound Coastal Alliance

- Smaller group – less diversity
 - Less formal governance structure
 - Capacity to wind up and down according to need for collaborative action
 - Less formal nature complimented rather than replicated PNP
 - Officer led
